QUEENSLAND BUILDING DESIGN AWARDS REGIONAL WINNERS AND REPRESENTATIVES FOR STATE DESIGN AWARDS

The 2008 Queensland Building Design Awards, Mackay Regional winners have been announced. All the winners will now represent their region, competing with winners from across the state for the prestigious Queensland Building Design Awards to be announced in August.

Mackay designers named regional winners

Glen Place of Place Designs was awarded the Custom Designed Homes 251 – 350 square metres category with Cannon Residence. The double storey beachside retirement home was designed with optimal passive cooling in mind. The open plan living, kitchen and dining areas open onto a private undercover outdoor entertainment area, complete with BBQ and pool. A balcony located on the upper level over the entertainment area. The colour scheme works perfectly to maintain the beachside character.

Lyneece Joblin Design Studio took out the Residential Alterations and Additions less than \$200,000 category award with the Anderson Residence. The project's transformed an existing carport and shed which required a complete redesign and extension to provide a small three bedroom residence with a substantial outdoor entertaining area. The modern style Queenslander adopts a traditional layout to maximise floor space, combined with contemporary finishes and vibrant colours.

Geoff Carhart won the Small Lot Housing category award with his design of Rapp House. The beach themed two storey home offers a massive kitchen space, with the dining and family area opening out onto the patio. Further adding to the flavour of the house is the curved roof which resembles ocean waves. The home has a colour scheme which complements the natural surrounds. This home typifies sophisticated beachside living.
